- It is evident that Professor Hepler cares about his students and is always available to answer questions during office hours and at the end of each class. He always tries to improve on an already good reference book (Rudin's) by modifying slightly the order of presentation of topics and also by sometimes providing his own proofs that are often times more easily understandable than the ones in the book. He brings freshness to this abstract subject and tries to present the material in a clear, almost self-evident way. Also, his homework assignments, exams and grading policy are fair. For all the above, and in short, I believe Professor Hepler makes this subject more enjoyable than what one might a priori expect from the traditional "dryness" of the topics covered.
- It is a marvellous course, I really enjoy it!
- I really liked the course. I feel like visual depictions were in general the most useful.
- Prof. Hepler is a great instructor who really took time to answer people's questions. The only issue I really had the entire semester was that he did not erase the chalkboard in the order that he wrote on it which led to me missing some parts of the notes. This did not happen everyday, but it happened enough to lead to gaps that I had to ask others to fill in.
- I think Brian did a good job of adjusting when things did not go as he wanted after the first exam. He went a little fast and didn't explain to the depth I would like but I also think that is a byproduct of the material itself being difficult to comprehend. I think Brian was a fine instructor in this class.
